 - a. How will this look different than what we have been doing?
- 6. Of the 5 categories talked about on Sunday, Widows, Elderly, Orphans, Single Parents, Special Needs, which would you be the most likely to engage with? Why?
- 7. What's the danger in NOT caring well for the "least of these" within our church?
- 8. What would be the danger of caring for those inside the church to the exclusion of those outside the church?
- 9. What part does caring for the "least of these" have in the Great Commission? (Matthew 28v18-20)
- 10. When you consider Sunday's message in terms of where Cross Road is going,
 - a. Does it excite you, stress you, or leave you unmoved? Why?
 - b. Can you envision yourself playing a part in advancing the Kingdom of God by caring for the vulnerable AND reaching out to those around us?
 - i. If so, where? If not, why?
